Hello Iconography students,

For the **practical class**:

- * We meet Monday through Saturday from 9 am - 4 pm.
- * Bring a notebook and pen to take plenty of notes.
- * Bring a terry hand-towel to rest your board on.
- * Beginners will work on Archangel Michael so you can learn the technique.
- * You can stay in the classroom working **only until 6 PM** as long as you promise to turn the lights off and lock the door behind you.
- * If you happen to have a small size desk lamp feel free to bring it along with an extension cord.
- * Bring cash to buy extra supplies, i.e. more boards, pigment kits (let me know in advance), etc. You do not need these for the workshop, but some people like to buy them to work at home after the workshop is over.
- * We usually start the class with a prayer and hope to keep the peaceful atmosphere throughout the day. Please try to keep chatting to a minimum. But if you have questions by all means ask them.
- * Food related items: coffee, tea bags, and hot water are usually provided. It is nice to bring your own mug so as not to generate so much trash. You are welcome to bring food to class if you want to share. But please **refrain from eating and drinking while painting**--it is not good for your health. Also, **wash your hands before you eat, drink or smoke**.
- * Please **do not lick the brushes either**. Some students who are used to working with watercolors develop this habit; but it is not recommended to do this while working with powder pigments. Some of them are toxic.
